

## **OFFICIAL 2007 DRAWING CONTEST RULES**

**I. General Information:** The Alarm Industry Foundation of Florida, Inc. ("AIFF"), a not-for-profit Florida corporation will be holding a drawing by chance to win one (1) 50" Plasma TV& Home Theater System. The AIFF is 501(c) (3) corporation established by members of the alarm industry to award scholarships to deserving students. Scholarships awarded by the AIFF are given for college education and other training purposes. All qualified individuals are eligible to apply for a scholarship and scholarships are awarded on a non-discriminatory basis.

**III. Payment Information.** Checks or money orders must be payable to "The Alarm Industry Foundation of Florida, Inc."

**IV. Eligibility.** You must be a U.S. resident, 18 years of age or older, to win.

**V. Prize/Drawing Information.** The prize awarded shall be (1) 50" Plasma TV& Home Theater System , subject to these rules:

**1.** The name of the winner will be made available to the media by the AIFF and will be posted on the AIFF website. In accepting the winning prize, the winner consents to having their name and photograph published in a variety of media in conjunction with promotional activities associated with the AIFF.

**2.** The winner will be selected by a random drawing conducted by judges appointed by the AIFF Board of Directors. The drawing will be held on Friday, March 9, 2007, at approximately 9:00 o'clock PM at the AAF Awards Banquet, Rosen Plaza Hotel, Orlando, Florida. The winner need not be present at time of drawing in order to collect their prize. The winner will be notified by telephone and by certified mail.

**3.** In order to be eligible to participate in the drawing, tickets must be submitted and placed in the AIFF official drawing bowl on or before 8:00P.M., March 9, 2007.

**4.** Arrangements will be made with the winner to receive possession of the 50" Plasma TV& Home Theater System through the offices of the Alarm Industry Foundation of Florida.

5. Upon receipt of the prize, the winner shall assume all responsibility for the awarded items, including any sales tax, warrantee registration, dealer prep, insurance, shipping or any other fees associated with the items.

7. A maximum of 2,500 tickets will be sold. In the event the total amount of tickets sold is less than 1,500, no items will be awarded. Instead, a cash prize equal to fifty percent of the total voluntary contributions received in conjunction with the drawing will be presented to the winner.

8. Only one name may be stated on the drawing ticket and order form. Any Social Security number provided must be that of the entrant. Presentation of the prize shall be made solely to the entrant. Late, misdirected, incomplete, illegible or damaged drawing tickets will not be eligible and the AIFF assumes no responsibility for same.
